***PRODUCT TYPE:**

- **MMC/HARP** means that MMC and HARP members who were not receiving Long Term Services & Supports (LTSS) from those plans will be default enrolled into the Medicare Dual-SNP and remain in their Medicaid MMC/HARP plan for Medicaid services.
- **MAP** means Medicaid Advantage Plus. This is for MMC and HARP members who **were** receiving Long Term Services & Supports (LTSS) from those plans (personal care or CDPAP service). They are being default enrolled into a MAP plan which combines Medicare Advantage with an MLTC and MMC plan all in one.
