Subsequent to July 2, 2001, calendars will be scheduled at 14 Boerum Place to handle issues involving actions taken by the NYC Human Resources Administration's DASIS (Division of Aids Services Income Support) Program. The instructions in this transmittal supersede those contained in OAH Transmittals 95-17, 98-02, and 99-45.

Communications Intake staff, upon identifying that a hearing requires notification to DASIS, will now input "NDAS"in the first Agency field when entering requests on the PFREQ1 screen on the Fair Hearing Information System (FHIS) and will input the appropriate Income Support Center (ISC) in the second Agency field. This will ensure that the appropriate contact person is provided notification of fair hearing requests, redirects, notices, adjournments, decisions, and complaints of non-compliance:

Communications Intake staff should be aware that any requests received from clients of ISC 24, 43, and 49 must be coded with NDAS in the first agency field, as these centers only handle DASIS cases. However, since ISC 43 and 49 are not yet programmed as viable agency fields in FHIS, Communications Intake staff are advised NOT to put N043 or N049 in the secondary agency field, or an error message will prevent transmitting from the screen. Staff will be advised at such time as these centers are available for entry in

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the secondary agency field. Coding for cases from ISC 043 and ISC 049 should, therefore, only reflect NDAS in the first Agency field, until further notice.

In the event that Communications Intake staff are unable to elicit the information necessary to the proper calendaring of these cases, it will be incumbent on the NYC HRA to notify the Office of Administrative Hearings utilizing the Agency Correction memorandum (OTDA-524EL). Upon receipt of the OAH-1891, Fair Hearing Request, when staff in the Income Support Centers are aware that the appellant's fair hearing request is the responsibility of an Income Support Center or program other than that noted in the Agency field on the OAH-1891, the DSS-524EL form (New York City FIA Memorandum) should be completed and faxed to (518) 473-6735. This will result in the appropriate change on the Fair Hearing Hearing Information System (FHIS) upon processing by the OAH Communication Intake Section, resulting in scheduling to the correct calendar.
