Effective October 1, 2001, a new issue code has been established for actions taken by the New York City Human Resources Administration's Medical Assistance Program (NYC HRA MAP) in situations where the client has been determined ineligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI). There are two major groups of SSI cases to which these actions pertain. One group consists of cases where there was no previous SSI eligibility to support the opening of the Medical Assistance Supplemental Security Income (MA SSI) case. The second group consists of those cases where eligibility for SSI has been terminated but there continues to be an active MA SSI case. The new issue code is as follows:

Issue Code 209 DISC/REDU/DEN of MA Due to Ineligibility for SSI

When setting up a fair hearing request on the Fair Hearing Information System (FHIS), Communications Intake staff can use this code for either type of case. The Client Notice Subsystem (CNS) closing code is 911. The notices include fair hearing rights and aid-continuing provisions. These notices are only being sent to NYC HRA MAP clients.

A revision, reflecting the new issue code, has been made to the FHIS Issue Codes on the OAH Intranet and a page replacement for the Desk Guide will be distributed, as appropriate.
