Please refer to the two attached notices (labelled Notice A and Notice B) that are examples of BEGIN issues which are generated by the Office of Employment Services (OES). Although these hearings may, in the near future, be scheduled at 16th Street, they will continue to be scheduled at 80 Centre Street for the present time. Most ADC employment-related issues are to continue to be scheduled against the agency NBEG even if the notice has OES in the upperright or upper-left section of the notice and appears to be generated by NOES. Please refer to OAH Transmittals 96-14, 96-15 and 96-17 for exceptions to this general procedure.
